ZOOM OUT

200 years ago: Industrial Revolution.

75 years ago: Nuclear weapons. Computers.

30 years ago: The Internet goes mainstream.

NOW: AI. Genetic engineering. Climate crisis. Space expansion.

THE PATTERN

Notice what's happening.

The gaps between major transitions keep shrinking. It took billions of years to go from single cells to complex life. Millions of years from mammals to humans. Thousands from agriculture to industry. Decades from computers to AI.
