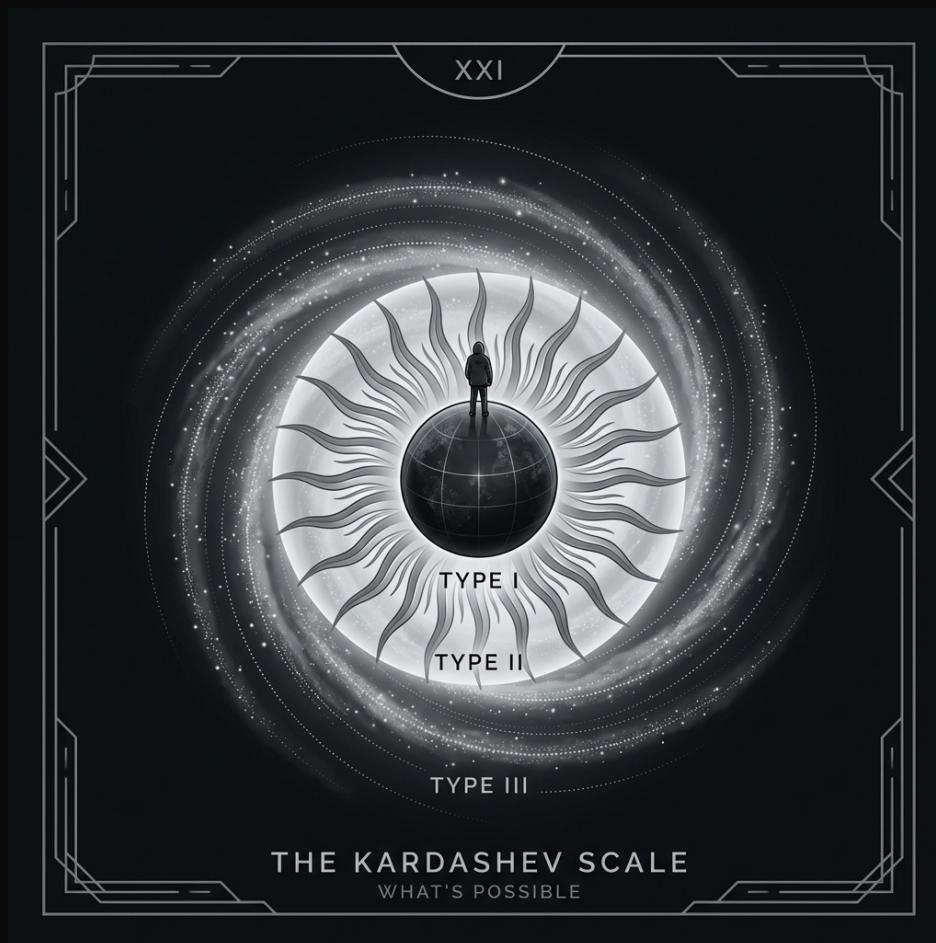


A WAY TO MEASURE CIVILIZATIONS

In 1964, Soviet astronomer Nikolai Kardashev proposed a simple but powerful idea: we can classify civilizations by how much energy they can harness.

Not by their art. Not by their philosophy. Not by their politics. By energy.

Why energy? Because energy is the universal currency of doing things. Every capability - from growing food to computing to space travel - requires energy. The more energy you can access and control, the more you can do.



The Kardashev Scale: measuring civilizations.

THE SCALE

TYPE I: PLANETARY CIVILIZATION

A Type I civilization harnesses all the energy available on its home planet: all solar energy hitting the planet, all geothermal energy, all wind, wave, and tidal energy. Complete control over weather and climate. Mastery of the planetary ecosystem.

Energy scale: $\sim 10^{16}$ to 10^{17} watts

TYPE II: STELLAR CIVILIZATION

A Type II civilization harnesses all the energy of its home star. Think Dyson spheres - megastructures that capture a star's entire output. Interplanetary by necessity.

Energy scale: $\sim 10^{26}$ watts

TYPE III: GALACTIC CIVILIZATION

A Type III civilization harnesses all the energy of its entire galaxy. Billions of stars. Probably involves capabilities we can't currently imagine.

Energy scale: $\sim 10^{36}$ watts

WHERE ARE WE?

Humanity is currently approximately Type 0.73.

WE'RE NOT EVEN TYPE I YET.



Humanity: ~73% of the way to Type I.

We're still burning fossil fuels. Still fighting over resources. Still vulnerable to a single asteroid. We haven't even mastered our home planet, let alone reached for the stars.

THE DANGEROUS TRANSITION

Here's the thing about the Kardashev Scale that keeps thoughtful people up at night:

THE TYPE 0 TO TYPE I TRANSITION IS THE MOST DANGEROUS.

At Type 0, you have:

- Weapons powerful enough to destroy yourselves
- No backup planet
- Global coordination problems you haven't solved
- Accelerating technology without accelerating wisdom
- Climate and resource crises of your own making

Most civilizations that reach this point probably don't make it through. They destroy themselves, collapse, or get stuck. The Great Filter may be right here.

WHAT TYPE I ACTUALLY MEANS

Making it to Type I isn't just about energy. It requires:

Global Coordination: Working together across all nations and cultures

Long-term Thinking: Planning in centuries, not quarters

Wisdom to Match Technology: Ethics and governance that can handle our power

Abundance Mindset: Moving beyond zero-sum competition

Planetary Identity: Seeing ourselves as one species, one planet

If we make it, the payoff is extraordinary: post-scarcity abundance, multi-planetary existence, capabilities we can barely imagine. The suffering that has defined human existence could become optional.

TYPE 0 vs TYPE I THINKING

The framework changes how you see things:

TYPE 0 THINKING	TYPE I THINKING
My nation vs. your nation	Humanity as a whole
This quarter's profits	This century's trajectory
Resources are scarce, fight	Technology creates abundance
Earth is everything	Earth is the starting point
Politics is ultimate game	Coordination is ultimate challenge
Future will be like past	Future will be radically different

OD9 is explicitly trying to cultivate Type I thinking. Not because Type 0 thinking is stupid - it made sense for most of human history. But because we're at the transition point, and Type 0 thinking will get us killed.

SUMMARY
